Before fishing in another waterbody:

- Remove plants, animals, and mud from all equipment.
- Drain all water from your boat and gear.
- Dry everything thoroughly with a towel.
- Dispose of unwanted bait, worms, and fish parts in the trash.

Remember to check these areas:

- Artificial lures.
- Nets.
- Bait buckets.
- Waders and boots.
