Join the Fight!

96% of Illinois waterfowl hunters are already fighting the spread of aquatic invaders (based on a survey of boat show attendees).

Before hunting in another waterbody:

- Remove plants, animals, and mud from all equipment.
- Drain all water from your boat and gear.
- Dry everything thoroughly with a towel.
- Brush hunting dogs, and hose down their gear and kennels with tap water.

Remember to check these areas:

- Blinds.
- Waders and boots.
- Decoys.
- Anchors and bags.
